FINAL INSTRUCTIONS



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Thank you very much for your entry, your start number is as per entry list found on rallies.info, balamotorclub.co.uk and the Facebook page. Confirm your number at noise as the list remains provisional up until commencement of noise.

1. START PROCEDURE

Fuel available pre-event at Thomas Motor Mart, Glan Yr Afon (map ref. 125/026/426) – however, no super unleaded is available. Please fill up if required before scrutineering; no car will be permitted to leave the start venue post completion of scrutineering.

Unload cars at the rear of Rhug Farm (map ref. 125/055/435) - please park trailers tidily. Please be as quiet as you can when returning to your trailer at the end of the event. Trailers are left at the venue at owners' own risk.

Report to noise as per attached diagram behind the sheep shed (map ref. 125/056/433). Collect process card; Please Write your car number on this process card.

Upon passing noise test report to Scrutineering as per attached diagram (map ref. 125/056/434) at the rear of the sheep shed

Trailer Park, Noise and Scrutineering diagram is attached at the end of this document.

After successful completion of scrutineering park your car as instructed by a Marshal. Once parked up, competing cars must not leave the start venue.

Your marshal should sign on with the Chief Marshal before you attend competitor's signing on. . PLEASE NOTE YOU AND YOUR MARSHAL MUST BE SIGNED ON BY 20.30HRS.

Report to signing on (see Diagram) to collect your pack – your documentation should have already been uploaded to the online entry form. WAMC Championship signing on forms will be found here also.

After successful completion of signing on, competitors will be issued with a rally pack containing rally plates, time cards, etc.

OUTLINE SCHEDULE

- Novices to attend scrutineering between 16:30 & 17:15
- Semi-experts to attend scrutineering between 17:15 and 18:15
- Experts and Masters to attend scrutineering between 18:15 and 20:00
- 21:30 Driver/Navigator Briefing; Mandatory for all crews please.

ASR 9

A reminder that all documentation (license, club card and insurance) is required to be uploaded by 18:00 on Friday 28th June 2024. Failing to do so will result in your position being offered to a reserve – we have plenty fully verified ready to go – **YOU HAVE BEEN WARNED!!**

ASR 12

Competitors are reminded that their competition numbers must be removed at the point of retirement, disqualification or at damage. This rule will be strictly enforced, and anyone failing to comply may be reported to Motorsport UK.

ASR 13

In line with the 2024 Blue Book all cars must carry a Spill Kit

ASR 14

Total mileage will be approximately 90 miles. Fuel will be available after approximately 25miles between SS1S and SS2S – NOTE: NO SUPER UNLEADED WILL BE AVAILABLE. There are a limited number of pumps therefore can we ask you to minimise your time spend at the fuel halt to avoid large ques forming.

The fuel halt will be **CASH ONLY!!!!**

Please ensure that you hand the relevant timecards in at the petrol halt.

Route information will be issued at MCO; the first novice crew will receive their route information 30 minutes before their due time at MCO to allow more plotting time. The official notice board will have a list of start times at MCO and MC1 for all crews.

Map cuts; Map 116; Keep bottom section below gridline 60. Map 125; Keep top section above gridline 20.

ASR16

A warning that any competitor found to be unnecessarily dropping time on neutral sections may be disqualified.

ASR 18

Once again competitors are reminded that in accordance with Section 170 of The Road Traffic Act 1988 and Rule 286 of The Highway Code, any incidents involving injury shall be reported to the Police Authority. Competitors will be expected to contribute towards any costs or claims incurred in respect to property caused by them. It is a condition of signing the entry form and Motorsport UK Signing on forms at the start that competitors accept this clause.

Catering facilities are available at the start venue up until 11.30pm

There is a strict no smoking policy within and around the start venue buildings and the finish area

Please ensure that you have written in your competition number on all event documentation

Breakfast tickets will be handed out post submission of Damage Declarations at MC2 at the finish venue

Please enter and leave Rhug Farm quietly when collecting your trailer to minimise noise and disruption to the local residents. Please do not hoot any car horns at any time during the night; this was the only PR request by local residents in and around the Rhug Farm area.

A strict 5mph speed limit exists at Rhug Farm; Please adhere to this

Portaloo's will be available at the start venue

PLEASE NOTE:

PR work before the event has identified some locations where local residents have requested disturbance to be minimised. Competitors MUST heed quiet zones along the route. There is no reason or excuse not to pay attention to these requirements; any crew not complying with these requirements will be DISQUALIFIED. DSO's will be present at these locations.

In the case of an emergency the event has a dedicated mobile phone 07903 712526. This will be carried by the Clerk of Course throughout the night. The number is also repeated on all your time cards. Should you be unlucky and have to retire please text the approximate location and reason to this number
