FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you very much for your entry, your start number is as per enclosed entry list.

Your start time will be 10.15am plus your car number in minutes at MC0. Your start time at MC1 will be 10.30am plus your car number in minutes.

START PROCEDURE

Unload cars and proceed to trailer park (see map) please park trailers tidily and with respect to other competitors. Trailers are left at the venue at owner's own risk.

Report to noise (see map). Collect process card; **Please Write your car number on this process card.**

Upon passing noise test report to Scrutineering (see map) please follow Marshals instructions.

Scrutineering times.

- Cars 31 - 45; 7.45 – 8.35am
- Cars 30 – 16; 8.00 – 9.10am
- Cars 15 – 1; 8.30 – 9.45am

After successful completion of scrutineering park your car up in the service area at the Ranges Once parked up, competing cars must not leave the start venue.

Report to signing on in the Green Container, making sure you have the relevant documentation: - process card, own insurance details and Marshal's details.. **PLEASE NOTE YOUR MARSHAL MUST BE SIGNED ON BY 9.30am.** Your marshal should sign on before you with the Chief Marshal before you attend competitor's signing on. **Remember No Marshal – No Start ASR12.** Please ensure that you have provided all other information online as per the Regulations. Marshals signing on will be in the White container

After successful completion of signing on, competitors will be issued with a rally pack containing rally plates, timecards, etc.

AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONS TO ASR'S

ASR 3.

D.O.E authorisation will be available at signing on for inspection.

ASR 7.

Please note individual scrutineering times above

Fuel is available at Trawsfynydd Petrol Station which will be passed a number of times during the day – Super Unleaded fuel is available at this venue. Time is built into road sections for you to re-fuel

Please ensure that both crews attend the Drivers briefing at the signing on Rally HQ at 10.00am prompt – both crew members must sign an attendance form to prove attendance – Penalty for non-attendance Disqualification

ASR 8.

Competitors are reminded that their competition numbers must be removed at the point of retirement, disqualification or at damage. This rule will be strictly enforced, and anyone failing to comply may be reported to Motorsport UK.

ASR 11; There will be additional awards as follows: -

Best crew in a 1400cc Courtesy of Sbardun, Pwllheli

Best-Mixed Crew

ASR 15.

Judges of Fact: All named officials and signed on Marshals.

Driving Standards Observers: A list Driving Standards Observers will be available for inspection on the official notice board.

ASR 16.

Special Test Penalties

1. Failure to Stop astride stop line or a “stop astride PC” 30 Seconds per offence (F)
2. Striking a route marker; 10 seconds per offence, each cone position will be marked on the ground, the penalty will be applied if the cone has moved outside its marked area (C)

3. Time taken less target time; Target time
4. Time taken greater than target time; Actual time
5. Deliberate damage to test furniture to gain an advantage; Test Maximum (X)
6. Failure to undertake a manoeuvre in accordance with route instructions on the test diagrams; 30 Seconds per offence (M)
7. Tyres not in accordance with ASR 20; Disqualification; Scrutineers will be at several test starts monitoring this; you have been warned.
8. Test maximums 7 minutes for a 1.5 mile test, 6 minutes for a 1.25 mile test, 5 minutes for a 1-mile test and 4 minutes for a 0.5mile test
9. If a PC shown on your timecard is un-manned, a code board route check will be in place; this will be a number plate on a timber post sited after the relevant chicane; please record the number plate information on your passage card; note the number plate will be changed for the second run if a code board is used!
10. Chicanes or manoeuvres shown on the test diagrams that are not PC's will be Marshaled and penalties applied as above for any infringements.

ASR 20 SCRUTINEERING

Please make sure that your car is compliant with all current Motorsport UK requirements, the scrutineers will be paying particular attention to tyres, handbrakes and interior trim, please make sure that all are compliant with Regulations. Non-compliant will mean No Start.

ASR 22.

You will be required to sign a declaration that you have compliant motor insurance to take part in the event at Signing on.

OTHER INFORMATION

- No cheques will be accepted at signing on, cash payments only for any outstanding fees
- All competitors must wear seatbelts / harnesses on all Sections at all times.
- We have been reminded by the Motorsport UK that all incidents which result in an injury need to be reported to the Police and the Stewards in accordance with Section 170 of The Road Traffic Act 1988 and Rule 286 of The Highway Code. If you are involved in an RTA during the event, please ring the Police non-emergency number – 101 – if the incident requires the attendance of the Emergency services the please ring 999 immediately
- Catering facilities are available at the finish venue up until approx. 5.30pm
- There is a strict no smoking policy within and around the start and finish venue
- Please ensure that you have written in your competition number on all event documentation
- Evening meal tickets will be handed out post submission of Damage Declarations at MC3 at the finish venue
- A strict 5mph speed limit exists at the start and finish venue; Please adhere to this
- WC's will be available at the start, rest halt and finish venue
- Please can we ask your Marshal and any spectators that come with you to park sensibly and tidily
- G Price Photographs is the official photographer for the event
- **NO IN CAR CAMERAS ARE PERMITTED**
- **Please travel as slowly and as quietly as you can through the Chalet Village at Bronaber at all times**

PLEASE NOTE:

PR work before the event has identified some locations where local inhabitants have requested disturbance to be minimised. Competitors **MUST** heed quiet zones along the route, all road sections have been timed generously so there is no reason or excuse not to pay attention to these requirements; any crew not complying with these requirements will be Disqualified. DSO's will be present at these locations.

In the case of an emergency, the event has a dedicated mobile phone 07554 332981. This will be carried by the Secretary of the Meeting throughout the day. The number is also repeated on all your timecards. Should you be unlucky and have to retire please text the approx location and reason for retirement to this number to this number
