

Final Instructions

Thank you for your entry, your start number is as per enclosed entry list, and your start time at MC 1 will be 23.00 Hrs plus your car number.

Please report to noise at the following times:-

1 - 25 Between 17.00 and 18.30 Hrs

26-50 Between 18.30 and 19.30Hr

51 -75 Between 19.30 and 20.30 Hrs

Start Procedure

The event will start from the Pavilion at Corwen (Map Ref: 125/081.5/435) No trailers will be allowed at the start venue. Fill up with fuel at Thomas Motor Mart (map ref: 125/026.426) Open until 20.00Hrs. Proceed directly to the trailer park at (125/078.5/436) via 125/073/448 and 125/082,5/441 Dep Swan unload there, and leave trailers there. Proceed to noise as per map enclosed, ensuring you have your pink car number in the front nearside of the windscreen so the marshals can get you in quickly off the A5. From noise follow marshals instructions to scrutineering and then park as per map. Report to signing on in the pavilion, remembering you will need your marshal before you can sign on. **Any competitor who fails to supply a marshal 90 minutes before their due start time, will forfeit their entry fee, and their place will be offered to the next reserve with a marshal.**

ASR 8 Competitors are reminded that their **competition numbers must be removed at the point of retirement, exclusion or at damage.** This rule will be strictly enforced, and anyone failing to comply, may be reported to the MSA.

ASR 9 Competitors should carry enough fuel to cover 80 miles.

ASR 16 (a) Not reporting or reporting OTL at a Main Control (MC) is now "Retirement"

Add:- Not reporting or reporting OTL at a Regularity Start (RS) is "1 Fail"

Not reporting or reporting OTL at a Regularity Interim Time Control (RITC) is "1 Fail"

Not reporting or reporting OTL at a Regularity Finish (RF) is "1Fail"

Penalty for reporting late at "RITC or RF" is "1 second per second"

Penalty for reporting early at "RITC" or RF" is "2 seconds per second"

ASR 17 Add Regularity Start (RS)

Add Regularity Interim Time Control (RITC)

Add Regularity Finish (RF)

Competitors must stop and receive a time and a signature at these controls.

face a fine.
